



DOLPHIN SCHOOL RULES

WELCOME. PLEASE READ AND SIGN YOUR AGREEMENT. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE SCHOOL.

1. In accordance with the Cambodian Child Protection Policy, volunteers must not put any of the children of any of our schools in a situation that might make them feel uncomfortable or disrespected. This includes lifting or carrying them, shouting at, or hitting them. Kissing, and other similar acts of affection are not appropriate. Horseplay sets a bad example for our students, please no piggyback rides, rough physical play etc. Students must not sit on volunteers' laps.

2. **Photos.** Please do not take photos during class time. Do not take photos without asking the children's permission. Any photos posted on social media must be group shots please.

3. **Smoking,** including e-cigarettes, is strictly prohibited in the Volunteer House, school grounds and surrounding areas, or anywhere near children.

4. Dolphin School accepts no responsibility for the personal safety of the volunteers or their possessions. Valuables may be placed in Mr. Yuth's safe. Any vehicles supplied by DSE are used at the volunteers own risk.

5. Volunteers are responsible for any loss or damage caused by them, including bicycles, keys, household items etc. All damage must be reported to Mr. Yuth.

6. Payment for your first month's stay is required, in full, within 48 hours of your arrival, and is nonrefundable.
7. A minimum of 5 hours work is required per day, including teaching, lesson and resource preparation, gardening, and general maintenance.
8. Respectable clothing must be worn when teaching. No underwear showing. No sleeveless, or cropped, tops. Shorts must be of a reasonable length. No hats or caps in class.
9. Volunteers first commitment must be to Mr. Yuth and Dolphin School. No other work/volunteering may be undertaken without his permission.
10. All volunteers must contribute to the smooth running of the Volunteer House by keeping it clean, respecting the quiet hours and other volunteers' possessions.
11. All volunteers must support the school in a positive manner, and not bring it, or Mr Yuth, into disrepute through word or action.
12. No alcohol is to be consumed by volunteers during the day. Evening drinking in moderation is acceptable.
13. Volunteers will be asked to leave immediately if they are found to have any illegal drugs in their possession.
